

Upgrade guide for OneStepCheckout

This document describes how you can upgrade to the latest version of OneStepCheckout. The way to proceed depends on the version you are currently running. No matter what version you are running, you have to take these precautions before proceeding:

*When you have an upgrade of OneStepCheckout, there is **almost always** made changes to the main template that is responsible for OneStepCheckout. This template file is called "checkout.phtml", and is by default located in "app/design/frontend/default/default/template/onestepcheckout/". If you have made any changes to this template file in your store, you need to make a backup of it before upgrading. If you have changed the template in default/default theme, it will be overwritten when you make an upgrade. If you have copied checkout.phtml into your themes directory (default/your_theme), you will need to synchronize your changes with the latest checkout.phtml from the upgrade.*

Now you need to find out what version of OneStepCheckout you are running. The main thing you need to figure out is if your current version is after the administration panel got restructured. You can figure this out by going into your backend under System -> Configuration.

If you have a menu item called "OneStepCheckout" in your left menu (below "Checkout"), you are **running version 2.0 or later of OneStepCheckout**.

If you don't have a menu item called "OneStepCheckout", but rather have some options for OneStepCheckout under the "Checkout" menu item, you are running a version **below 2.0 of OneStepCheckout**.

Upgrade instructions for version 2.0 and above

- 1) Unzip the package into a local directory on your computer
- 2) Upload the contents of the directory (should be three folders) directly into the Magento root. Choose to overwrite all files when asked
- 3) Go into your Magento administration and refresh the cache
- 4) Visit OneStepCheckout in your store and make sure everything is working properly.

PS: As mentioned, if you have made any changes to checkout.phtml in default/default before upgrading, these will be overwritten when you upload the latest version. If you have copied checkout.phtml into your theme's directory (example default/your_theme), you will need to synchronize these changes with the newest checkout.phtml from the template. If you forget to synchronize the changes, you might get unexpected behaviour because the new version of OneStepCheckout will then use a checkout.phtml from a previous version, and then anything can happen.

Upgrade instructions for OneStepCheckout version below 2.0

- 1) Unzip the package into a local directory on your computer
- 2) Upload the contents of the directory (should be three folders) directly into the Magento root. Choose to overwrite all files when asked
- 3) Go into the Magento administration and refresh the cache
- 4) Logout from the administration and login again to get access to new settings page
- 5) Visit "OneStepCheckout" in your left menu in the System -> Configuration page and set all your settings again (they will be reset after upgrading). **Important to fix the serial or your store will not work.**
- 6) Visit OneStepCheckout in your store and make sure everything is working properly.
